Resurrect the passion I once had for bringing the best of my inner goodness to the situations that claim my attention.

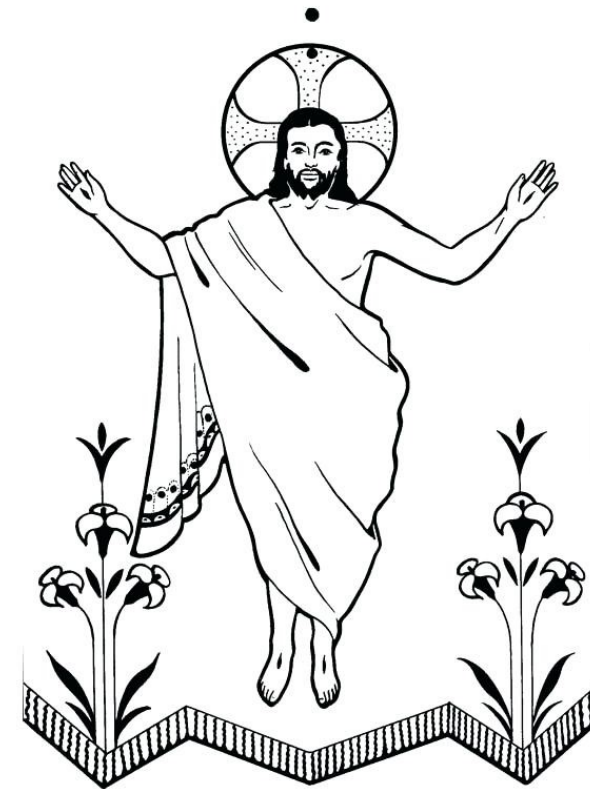
Release the door of my heart to allow me enter the tender moments and unforeseen experiences holding the promise of great happiness if only I am open to them.
