**Open our eyes, Oh God.**

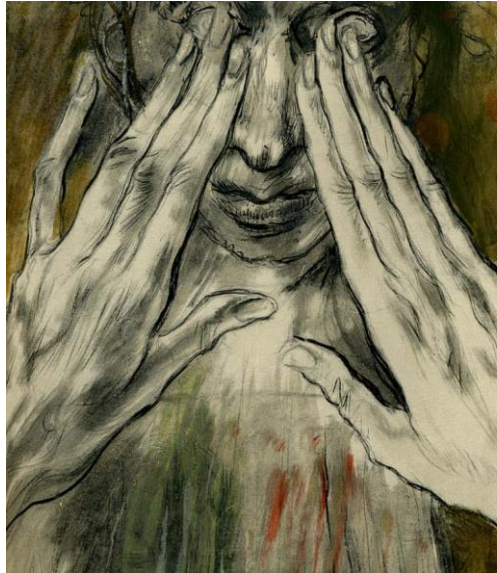
To all the ways we've been blind to the suffering of others,

**Open our eyes, Oh God.**

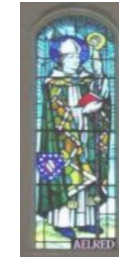

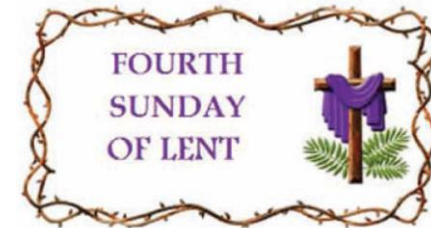
