### Celebration of Mass at St Aelred's

It has been very encouraging to see so many people returning to the celebration of Mass. The reduced seating capacity, one-way system and duty stewards who assist worshippers and sanitise the building after each service has made the church as Covid- secure as possible.

The Bishops have suspended the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and Holy Days, where possible people who can do so are encouraged to attend weekday Masses to leave space for others who can only attend at the weekend.

**In order to avoid avoid having to turn anyone away from Mass you are asked not to turn up without booking a place at the scheduled Mass times.**

**The system of online registration and telephone booking has been set up so that we are able to comply with the restriction on numbers and can be accountable under the Governments Track and Trace Programme. To this end, details of all worshippers must be retained for 21 days following any visit to the church.**

**In response to Government requirements those attending Mass are asked to wear a face-covering unless there are medical grounds for not doing so.**
